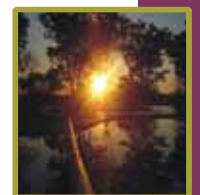

Introduction *"the beginning of an idea..."*

Harvesters in Sport is an Interdenominational Christian organisation that works with Communities through Camps, Sport, Sport-based Charity, Coaching Clinics, Workshops and Conferences in order to empower an individual mentally, physically and spiritually. We work with all age groups and are gradually expanding the scope of our activities with the objective of fulfilling our mandate. The focus of HIS is to become a vehicle for sports outreach and charity work to mobilize resources both inside and outside Zimbabwe for the development of a grassroots sports ministry.

Mission activities include Sports, Camps, Men's and Women's Teams, International Tours, Major Sporting Events, OVC Ministry, School Ministry and Prison Ministry with the inherent flexibility to expand as we grow.

History *"a journey of a thousand miles..."*

After conception, the HIS Trust was registered in 2004, and in January 2005, Harvesters in Sport (HIS) was established in Harare, Zimbabwe by Hatiatyi Prosper Kwenda. Since then it has been running camps and sporting/ coaching clinics with local institutions – Corporate and Academic.

In 2006 alone, HIS has worked with the Ministry of Social Welfare, the Ministry of Education, Sport and Culture, ZIFA, and Foreign Coaches from Ireland, USA, and Canada. HIS is also a workman with other like-minded organisations such as Ambassadors in Sport, Athletes in Action, Youth Encounter and Oasis Zimbabwe.

Mission Statement *"why we work..."*

Our primary purpose is to share the message of Jesus Christ through the environment of **Sport**, **Charity Work**, and **Community Development**.

Visionary Goals *"the latter days..."*

WORK: Develop indigenous sports ministries in Zimbabwe and SADC, and Christ focused works of charity.

WORKMAN: Recruiting, training and mobilizing people in strategic locations to assist in our programs.

WORKING: Work with selected orphanages at first with a view to establishing our own.

NETWORKS: Promote sports using tournaments, coaching clinics and sports camps.

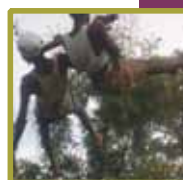

HIV/AIDS – In conjunction with other players in this field we wish to see a reduced rate of prevalence and infection and restoration of morality in our society. Condom use does not solve the HIV/AIDS problem (it plays a part) only abstinence and faithfulness. Case studies of countries like Uganda are a case in point.

Scope of Influence 2006 "our network coverage..."

HiS has conducted Team Building, Leadership, Sports, Environmental, and De-Stress Camps and Day Activities for more than 10 Schools and 3 Corporate Institutions in 2006, totalling 25 events in one year alone, who have become part of our calendar, with more than one event lined up for each. Some of the institutions include Heritage School, Phoenix College, Harare Junior Council, Standard Chartered Bank, and many primary schools in Harare North and Eastern parts of the Capital.

Through our Community biased camps, we have managed to captivate an audience of more than 10,000 from the schools students that attend our two major camps for Juniors and Seniors every April and December respectively. These camps give us access to more children whom we reach out using our follow up programs. Examples are Avonlea, Hulingbury and Avondale Primary Schools.



We value our fleet of highly trained Volunteers, which now stands at 43 school leavers and professionals, available at every event, to equip and deliver the HiS package – Empowerment through Sport.

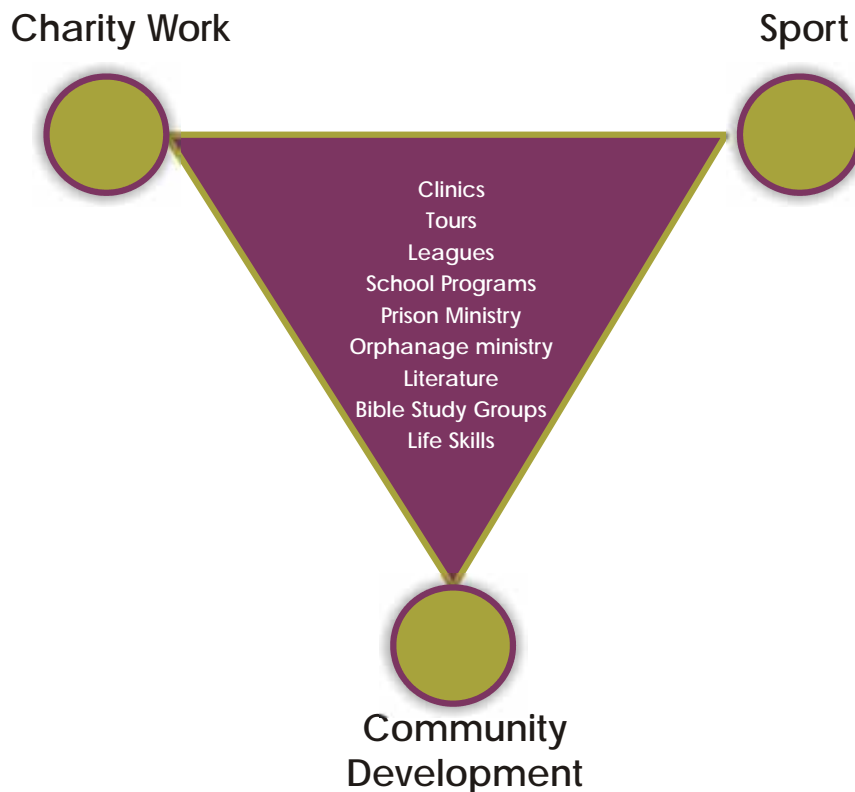

Including:

Project Facilitation: Facilitate on behalf of international partners, groups and volunteers to perform charity projects.

HIV/AIDS Awareness: Disseminate information and raise awareness on the dangers of HIV/AIDS as we come into contact with people through our work.

Partnerships: Partner with churches and other organisations who share our vision.

Mobile Ministry Teams: Create mobile teams that travel from place to place to provide assistance, aid and the gospel.

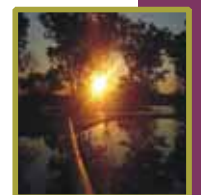
